The Edge of Innocence, a historical fiction novel, tells the story of a 1964 murder trial in which Miraldi's father was one of two defense attorneys. Beach, Breeze, Bloodshed, the second novel for Keyse-Walker, continues the story of Constable Teddy Creque from Sun, Sand, Murder, winner of the 2015 Minotaur Book/Mystery Writers of America First Crime Novel Award.
